Supervisor informed the town board that the Town of Schuyler received a bill for \$98,000.00 for replacing the expansion joint and cement work, the work that was done on the Town of Frankfort was \$48,000.00; the Town of Frankfort and the Town of Schuyler will have to split the total cost of \$146,000.00, which works out to 73,000.00 each. Also he wanted to thank the Highway Department for taking care of a tree that had fallen in Oakview Cemetery.
